

#1. PSAT Vocabulary words. Student generated lessons for week two. Vocabulary groups must prepare a lesson for your words below. The lesson must provide your fellow students with an activity they can do (either as individuals or in groups) that helps them learn the words themselves. They need to know the definition, the part (or parts) of speech (noun, verb, adjective), and how the word can be used in a sentence. Budget *at least* ½ hour for your lesson and activity. Longer is OK. Remember that kids get bored easy so keep them busy!
